

- a) District Magistrate / Additional District Magistrate / Collector / Sub-divisional Magistrate / Mandal Revenue Officer
- b) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahsildar
- c) Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the Candidate and / or his family normally resides

16. RESERVATION FOR SPECIAL CATEGORIES

All Special Category reservations are applicable to the Local Candidates of Telangana State only. Vacancies reserved for Special Categories i.e., National Cadet Corps (NCC); Home Guard (HG); Children of Police Personnel (CPP); Children of Deceased & Incapacitated police personnel (CDI); Children of Prisons Department Personnel (CJP); and Children of Special Protection Force Personnel (CSPF) shall be adjusted in a horizontal manner i.e., the reservation of Special Category Candidates shall be adjusted proportionately in the respective Communal Category to which the Candidate belongs. The percentage of vacancies reserved for the above Special Categories shall be calculated for each category based on the vacancies notified.

17. INSTRUCTIONS TO BE READ CAREFULLY

The requisite Educational qualification, Age, Physical standards, Procedure to be followed for selection etc., is given below. Candidates must read the instructions given in this Notification carefully in their own interest.

18. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS (CANDIDATES TO ENSURE THEIR ELIGIBILITY FOR THE EXAMINATION)

Candidates applying for the examination should ensure themselves that they fulfil all the eligibility conditions for admission to the examination. Their admission at all the stages of the Examination(s) / Test(s) will be purely provisional and shall be subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions.

Mere issue of Hall Ticket to the Candidate will not imply that his / her candidature has been finally cleared by the Board.

TSLPRB will take up verification of eligibility conditions with reference to Original documents only after the Candidate has finally qualified or at an appropriate time.

A. Eligibility by Gender: For Post Code Nos. 21 and 22, both Men and Women are eligible; for Post Code Nos. 23, 24, 25, 26 & 27 only Men are eligible and for Post Code No. 28 only Women are eligible.

B. Age Limit (General)

i) For the Post Code Nos.21 to 26:

- a) Must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 22 years as on 1st July, 2022 i.e., must have been born not earlier than 2nd July, 2000 and not later than 1st July, 2004. However, the Government of Telangana vide GO Ms No. 48, General Administration (Services-A) Department dated 13-04-2022 have raised the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment by **3 (three years)** for uniformed services including Police, Fire Services, Prisons and Special Protection Force Departments. This relaxation is in addition to the upper age limit as mentioned above.
- b) For Home Guards, a Person who, as on the date of Notification, has been on duty as Home Guard for a minimum duration of 360 days within a period of 2 (two) years and who is still continuing his / her service as Home Guard, must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 40 years as on 1st July, 2022 i.e., must have been born not earlier than 2nd July, 1982 and not later than 1st July, 2004. However, the Government of Telangana vide GO Ms No. 48, General Administration (Services-A) Department dated 13-04-2022 have raised the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment by **3 (three years)** for uniformed services including Police, Fire Services, Prisons and Special Protection Force Departments. This relaxation is in addition to the upper age limit as mentioned above.

ii) **For the Post Code Nos. 27 & 28:** Must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 22 years as on 1st July, 2022 i.e., must have been born not earlier than 2nd July, 2000 and not later than 1st July, 2004. However, the Government of Telangana vide GO Ms No. 48, General Administration (Services-A) Department dated 13-04-2022 have raised the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment by **3 (three years)** for uniformed services including Police, Fire Services, Prisons and Special Protection Force Departments. This relaxation is in addition to the upper age limit as mentioned above.

iii) **For the Post Code Nos. 21, 22 & 28 (For Women Candidates):** In the case of a Widow, a Divorced Woman or a Woman judicially separated from her husband and who is not remarried,

- a) SC & ST Candidates must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 40 years as on 1st July, 2022 i.e., she must have been born not earlier than 2nd July, 1982 and not later than 1st July, 2004. However, the Government of Telangana vide GO Ms No. 48, General Administration (Services-A) Department dated 13-04-2022 have raised the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment by **3 (three years)** for uniformed services including Police, Fire Services, Prisons and Special Protection Force Departments. This relaxation is in addition to the upper age limit as mentioned above.

- b) In all other cases (other than SC & ST), the Candidate must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 35 years as on 1st July, 2022 i.e., she must have been born not earlier than 2nd July, 1987 and not later than 1st July, 2004. However, the Government of Telangana vide GO Ms No. 48, General Administration (Services-A) Department dated 13-04-2022 have raised the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment by **3 (three years)** for uniformed services including Police, Fire Services, Prisons and Special Protection Force Departments. This relaxation is in addition to the upper age limit as mentioned above.

Note: A women Candidate claiming Age relaxation by virtue of being either a Widow or a Divorcee or a Woman judicially separated should produce the following documentary evidence.

- (i) In case of Widow, Death Certificate of her husband together with the Affidavit duly notarised that she has not re-married since.
- (ii) In case of Divorced Women and Women judicially separated from their husband, a certified copy of the Judgment / Decree of the appropriate court to prove the fact of divorce or the judicial separation, as the case may be, along with an Affidavit duly notarised that she has not re-married since.

C. Relaxations in Upper Age Limit: The Upper age limit prescribed above is however relaxable in the following cases:

2	Ex-Servicemen (Served in Army / Navy / Air Force / Territorial Army)	3 (three) Years in addition to the length of Service rendered in the Armed Forces
3	NCC Instructor (rendered a minimum service of 6 months as a whole time Cadet Corps Instructor in NCC)	3 (three) Years in addition to the length of Service rendered in the NCC
4	SCs, STs, BCs and EWS category	5 (five) Years
5	Retrenched temporary employee in the State Census Department with a minimum service of 6 months during 1991	3 (three) Years

Save as provided above, the age limits prescribed can in no case be relaxed.

Note: 1. Persons serving in the Armed Forces of the Indian Union, who on Retirement from Service, would come under the category of Ex-Servicemen, may be permitted to apply for re-employment one year before the completion of the specified terms of engagement and avail themselves of all concessions available to Ex-Servicemen

2. Name and date of birth accepted by the TSLPRB is that entered in the Secondary School Certificate or Matriculation or an equivalent examination certificate. No other document relating to Age like horoscopes, affidavits, birth extracts from Municipal Corporation, Service Records and the like will be accepted

D. Educational Qualification: Must have passed Intermediate or its equivalent examination recognized by the State Government as on 1st July 2022.

Provided that, Intermediate Pass Certificate cum Memorandum of Marks or any equivalent pass Certificate which proves the qualification shall be made available by the Candidate at the time of certificate verification to prove his / her qualification on or before 1st July 2022. If any Candidate fails to produce the required pass certificate as above on the designated day, then it shall be deemed that he / she does not possess required qualification and such candidature shall not be taken forward. Any certificates produced after the last date of Certificate Verification shall not be taken into consideration.

Note: Candidates who possess higher qualification than the prescribed one will also be considered on par with the Candidates who possess the prescribed qualification.

E. Medical Standards:

i. Eye Sight: Visual Standards required for the above selection shall be as follows

Right Eye Left Eye

Distant Vision	6/6	6/6

- ii. Each eye must have a full field of vision
- iii. Colour blindness, squint or any morbid condition of the eye or lids of either eye shall be deemed to be a disqualification
- iv. Candidate should possess sound health and be free from any bodily defect or infirmity which will render him / her unfit for the Posts notified
- v. Candidates who have the following ailments or defects will not be considered for recruitment to any of the Post notified

➤ Physically Handicapped

- Knocking-Knees, Pigeon Chest, Flat Foot, Varicose Veins, Hammer Toes, Fractured Limbs, Decayed Teeth, Stammering, Hard of Hearing and Abnormal Psychological Behaviour.
- vi. Candidates provisionally selected shall be referred to the District Headquarter Hospital for examination of their Medical Fitness. For any expert opinion, Candidates shall be referred to Osmania / Gandhi Hospitals, Hyderabad on the basis of the recommendations made by the District Headquarters Hospitals. Candidates who are declared unfit in eye related issues shall be referred to the Sarojini Devi Eye Hospital, Hyderabad based on the recommendation made by the District Headquarters Hospital. The Candidates can be referred / examined only once on such recommendations

Note: In order to avert getting disappointed at a later stage, Candidates are advised to have themselves examined by a Civil Surgeon before applying for the examination to ensure that they meet the prescribed Physical and Medical Standards.

19. SELECTION PROCEDURE / SCHEME

The Selection Procedure / Scheme of the Examination will be as follows --

A) Preliminary Written Test (PWT): All the eligible registered Candidates shall be required to appear for the Preliminary Written Test in one paper (three hours duration) for 200 marks (200 Questions). Hall Ticket will be issued Online for this purpose. Syllabus for the PWT is given at Annexure - II.

Note: 1) The minimum marks to be secured by the Candidates in order to qualify in the Preliminary Written Test paper is 30% for all categories i.e., OCs / BCs / SCs / STs / Ex. Servicemen

2) Questions in the Paper shall be objective in nature and shall be set in English, Telugu and Urdu languages. Candidates have to answer the questions on an OMR answer sheet using Blue / Black Ball Point pen only

3) For each question, the Candidate shall be awarded full marks, assigned to that question, if he / she darkened only one bubble that corresponds to the correct answer. In case the Candidate has not darkened any bubble, the Candidate shall be awarded zero mark for that question. In all other cases, 20% of full marks shall be awarded as negative mark for that question

Intimation Letter: Candidates who qualify in the Preliminary Written Test will be informed the dates for downloading the Intimation Letter through the website www.tslprb.in for appearing in the PMT / PET with details of Venue, Date and Time. Candidates should bring the Intimation Letter while attending the PMT / PET
