#### 1. Objective:

This will help them pursue their dream, bring acclaim & laurels to the country and inspire younger generation for engaging in sports activities.

### 3. Economic Weaker Section (EWS) Representation:

Everything being equal (in case of a tie of scores for evaluation) , preference shall be given to sports persons belonging to EWS category at all levels of representation, for which the applicant would be required to submit EWS certificate, of previous financial year issued by the Competent Authority, duly notified by Govt. of India, from time to time.

### 4. Eligibility, Age Criteria & duration of scholarship:

- 4.1 Sportsperson should be an Indian citizen and should not be availing any scholarship / stipend from any other organization during the scholarship period. An undertaking in this regard shall be submitted by the applicant.
- 4.2 The scholarship shall be granted to the sportspersons of **14 to 25 years of age**. Minimum age of 14 years will be considered as on 1<sup>st</sup> April of the year of scholarship. However, minimum age criteria for scholarship in **Chess, Gymnastics & Swimming will be 10 years**.
- 4.3 The maximum age for which scholarship can be granted is 25 years. **Therefore, applicant's upto the age of 24 years as on 1<sup>st</sup> April of the year of scholarship can apply for the sports scholarship.**
- 4.4 Scholarships shall be granted for FY 2023-24.
- 4.5 Being merit based sports scholarship, each sportsperson will have to apply afresh every year.

### 5. Document for proof of Age:

1. Birth certificate / Passport / Aadhar Card / 10<sup>th</sup> Class certificate (**any two**)

## 6. Scholarship amount :

The amount of Scholarship to be granted to the selected sports persons will be as under:

## 7. Benefits & Facilities to the Sportspersons:

- 7.1 Sportspersons on scholarship may be given opportunity to represent ONGC Team in PSPB / AIPSSPB tournaments and other competitions within country on directions of Head Sports. Such players shall be paid TA / DA and necessary expenditure for participation in the tournaments.
- 7.2 Sportspersons on scholarship shall also be provided playing kits with ONGC logo which they shall wear during their participation in the competitions.
- 7.3 Scholarship holder may avail individual health insurance cover for Rs. 5,00,000/- (Five lakhs only) for self. The individuals shall acquire requisite health insurance cover on their own and premium upto Rs. 7,000/- shall be reimbursed by ONGC.

## 8. Liability waiver:

ONGC shall neither be held liable for any loss / damage / injury / disability caused to any said sports scholarship holder nor shall indemnify any of the said sports scholarship holder towards such loss / damage / injury / disability which may arise or occur while performing any such sports activity.

## 9. Criteria for selection:

The proficiency of the sports person will be evaluated on the basis of their participation / performance in National & International tournaments / events recognized by National / International Sports Federations / Associations.

- 9.1 The criteria for **Badminton, Billiards & Snooker, Golf, Shooting, Squash, Table Tennis, Tennis and Para Games** where ranking at International / National level is available, the same shall be considered as criteria for selection for scholarship as given below:
  - (a) Latest **National & International Singles Rankings available on the closing date of the submission of applications** will be considered for selection.
  - (b) Evaluation will be based on **total points scored in both National & International rankings** as per table given below:

- (c) Any tie in points will be broken in following sequence:
- Based on better International ranking and if required,
  - Based on better National ranking

9.2 The Evaluation Criteria for **Athletics, Archery, Basketball, Boxing, Carrom, Football, Gymnastics, Hockey, Kabaddi, Swimming, Volleyball, Wrestling & Para Games** will be based on following score matrix:

- a. Evaluation will be based on performance in National & International tournaments / championships recognized by National / International Sports Federations / Associations held between 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 & last date of submission of application.
- b. **One single best performance / achievement** of the evaluation period will be considered for evaluation as per the score matrix given in the table above.
- c. In case of a tie in scores of sportspersons, their next best performances will be considered, till the tie is broken.
- d. If the tie could not be broken by criteria as given above, **opinion of an outside expert of the game / sport shall be final.**
- e. **In Athletics**, tie shall be broken on the basis of better Timing / Distance / Height achieved by a sportsperson in the championships / meets under evaluation.
